ODYSSEY

This exhibition, on the occasion of Posidonia, the prestigious international shipping festival, unfolds the awe-inspiring story of the Odyssey, in a romantic and abstract way, assigning to art a guiding, explanatory but at the same time emotional role.

The Odyssey has proven to be one of the most important, beloved and eternally appealing subject matters, both in literature and painting. In this exhibition, each work was chosen for its visual, emotional, and even associative relationship with key words of the Odyssey. The artists, inspired by the hero, the characters, the travels, the adventures, the sufferings but also the journey and spiritual uplifting, compose a modern version of the myth: a present-day visual feast, which awakens all emotions.

24 works by Greek and international artists are combined and accompanied by 24 pivotal verses from the Odyssey, dedicated to the 24 rhapsodies of the Homeric epic, comprising 12,110 verses that are still relevant today, providing a handbook on love, kindness, revenge, faith, respect, death, art and ultimately our very lives.
